Know what you are getting into

Decide on your goal for the interview

Who is the audience?

Prepare three key messages Think of soundbites and headlines Work out how to bridge to key messages Plan supporting facts, figures and examples

### During the interview...

Do

- Use short, direct answers
  Bridge to get your point across
  Talk solutions instead of problems
  Speak clearly
  Use open body language
  Stay cool and confident
  Use anecdotes and examples
  Don't
  Use jargon
- 🗶 Use interviewer's negative language
- K Let false charges stand uncorrected
- X Fall victim to hypothetical situations
- 🗶 Bluff if you don't know, say so
- X Say "no comment" or be defensive
- X Speak off the record
